- Volunteers will be responsible for the cost of their own air travel (\$800.00-1,200.00, depending on the time of the year, from the USA to Fortaleza, Brazil and return).
- The cost for in-land transportation, lodging & food starts at US\$350.00 per person and up, for ten-day missions. The basic fee covers lodging in a local inn, three meals a day, drinking bottled water, inland transportation during the project and a one-day local tour. Extra expenses such as extra tours, souvenirs, etc., will be additional).
- Volunteers are expected to assist with fund raising to cover project/building expenses. These contributions vary from a minimum of \$200.00 to \$500.00, per participant, to be agreed with the team leader, based on the nature of the project being carried out.
- A tourism visa is required to enter Brazil. Consult a Brazilian consulate or our web site for more information.
